



**6. EMD**

Rs. 50000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand) only per tender. The Earnest Money Deposit will be paid in the shape of demand Draft only in favor of **DMO (Medical Services) cum superintendent, DHH Boudh** from any Nationalized /Scheduled Bank payable at Boudh. The EMD will be refunded to the unsuccessful bidders after finalization of the tender process and the EMD of qualifying bidders will be retained upto the validity of the tender period & will be refunded after successful completion of supply of items within the stipulated time-period.

**No EMD amount is required for the bidders who have deposited & participated in the first tender of F.Y. 2018-19 & whose EMD have not been returned to them and this should be clearly mentioned in the remark col. of the check list.**

**7. General Conditions for supply of Drugs:**

- At the time of supply, the supplier must submit test report of the batches being supplied from a **NABL / Government approved laboratory** that the supplied drugs are of standard quality based on which the Drugs can be used or distributed.
- The district will also do random testing of the supplied drugs if required for which quality testing, packing & forwarding charges if any will be borne by the supplier.
- The supply is to be made in less number of batches (less than 3) and should arrive at Sub store with remaining 5/6<sup>th</sup> self life time. The supply should be made in good packing condition & labeling as "**ODISHA GOVERNMENT SUPPLY, NOT FOR SALE**" on the body of the stripe / bottle / ampoule / vial. No M.R.P. should be mentioned on the body of the stripe / bottle / ampoule / vial.
- The quoted price must be inclusive of all taxes. All bills should contain the **Goods & Service Tax Number (G.S.T.N)**, So far as GST is concerned.
- After receipt of all the batches of all Items / Drugs, randomly chosen items by the authority will be sent for quality testing or the Drug Inspector, Boudh range, Boudh may be intimated to take sample for quality testing. If any batch of any item / drug comes out to be NOT OF STANDARD QUALITY (NSQ), the supplier of firm will replace the full stock of that batch no. and take back the available NSQ stocks from different Health Institution of the District at his own cost. No payment will be made for the replacement of NSQ drugs with good quality drugs.

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- f) If the firm / supplier doesn't replace the full stock of that batch of item declared NSQ within one month of issue of the letter, he will be derecognized for that product and no payment will be made to him for that product or if he has taken the payment for that product the total cost of that batch of NSQ drugs will be deducted from any payment due for him or from the EMD and no further orders will be given to him for that product.
- g) Bidders who had been approved & issued supply order for supply of items, but failed to supply as per terms and conditions of the order, are ineligible to participate in the bidding process. Bids if received of these firms will not be considered for evaluation & will be rejected summarily.
- h) Delivery: The items as per supply order to be delivered to Sub-store of DMO (MS) cum Supt.DHH Boudh.
- i) The supplier needs to submit all original tender papers signed on each page as acceptance to terms & conditions of the quotations, otherwise the quotation will be rejected.
- j) The bidder will have to deposit 2% of purchase order value towards processing fees and quality testing fees in shape of Demand Draft in favor of **DMO (Medical Services) cum Superintendent., DHH Boudh** after placement of order failing which the consignment will not be accepted.
- k) The bidder will have to deposit 5% of purchase order value in shape of Demand Draft in favor of **DMO(Medical Services) cum Superintendent., DHH Boudh** which is refundable after completion of tender term period towards performance security. If the performance security will not accompany with the consignment, the consignment will not be accepted. In that case the order will be placed to L2.
- l) The rate must be quoted in the format enclosed in the original tender paper as financial bid. Rate quoted in any other format will be rejected.

#### 8. Pre-qualification:

- A. Manufacturing units / Authorized dealers / Traders are eligible to participate in the tender provided, they have:
- (i) Valid manufacturing Drug license along with list of products approved for manufacture, GMP/ WHO of the manufacturers.
  - (ii) Valid ISO certificate of the manufacturers.
  - (iii) GST return certificate for the June 2018 and PAN Card of the firm & GST registration no.
  - (iv) The firm must have Annual turnover of at least Rs.1 Crore for each year. The last three years (i.e. 2015-16, 2016-17 and 2017-18) will be taken into count. The firm must submit statutory audit report of the firm duly certified by Chattered Accountant in support of this.
  - (v) Valid manufacturing, Drug license of the manufacturing firm to be submitted along with bid.
  - (vi) Bidders who have been blacklisted either by the Tender inviting authority or by any district / state Govt. or Central Govt. organization for the quoted item is not eligible to participate in the tender during the period of blacklisting. (Notary) Affidavit of the same to be submitted stating that the firm has neither been black listed nor any criminal cases pending against them.
  - (vii) Must have valid drug license of the bidders.
  - (viii) Experience Certificates from the Government organization in Odisha state only in support of marketing experience for more than one year within the span of last 5 years in Tender for supply of Drugs & Medical Consumables along with Purchase Orders from the concerned organization.
  - (ix) A satisfactory completion certificate from concerned organization regarding supply of items must be submitted.
- B. Authorized distributors / traders are eligible to participate in the tender provided that:-
- (i) They should submit manufacturer's authorization to transact business on behalf of the manufacturer.
