Sub: Tri-monthly FPS Dealer-wise allocation of **Additional Rice** for families under the **State Food Security Scheme (SFSS)** for the month of **September-2021, October-2021 & November-2021**.

Ref: FS & CW Department allotment Order No. **10967** Dated - **03.08.2021**

Madam / Sir,

With reference to the subject cited above, the **provisional** allotment order of **Additional Rice** under **State Food Security Scheme (SFSS)** for the month of **September-2021, October-2021 & November-2021** issued by FS & CW Department, Odisha, Bhubaneswar, is hereby re-allotted for necessary distribution. A stock of **Q. 2197.20** of rice for the month of **September-2021, October-2021 & November-2021** from State Pool is to be distributed among the eligible beneficiaries under the **State Food Security Scheme (SFSS)** as per enclosed statement.

The scale of distribution of **Additional Rice** under the **State Food Security Scheme (SFSS)** is 05 Kgs per person per month on free of cost. The allotted stock of rice should be released only to those Fair Price Shops (FPSs) which have valid FPS license for the Financial Year 2021-22.

Distribution of Rice and Wheat at FPS point should be made only through E-PoS Device wherever PoS device has been delivered to the FPS. Sales through manual mode should be discouraged as far as practicable. However, in case of any exigencies or in worst circumstances, such manual mode of distribution should be resorted to only after due approval of concerned ADM, BDO/EO or CSO with proper justification. In such case, the transaction records must be processed through e-PoS and data shall be synced to the FPS server subsequently. The instructions issued vide FS & CW Department Letter No. 11408 dated 17<sup>th</sup> July, 2020 shall be followed meticulously in this regard. The stock account must be entered in RCMS Centre at the end of the distribution for generation of Closing Balance.

MOs/ISs In-Charge of the Blocks/ULBs shall deduct the closing balance / physical balance / verified balance quantities of foodgrains available in the Fair Price Shops (FPSs) of previous allocation month(s) from the allotted stocks of above allotment month(s), in account of PMGKAY-I & II (if any) and ask the dealer to lift the balance stocks from RRC-cum-DSCs.

All Fair Price Shops (FPSs) shall carry out Aadhaar authenticated distribution of PDS commodities as was being done earlier.

All Fair Price Shops (FPSs) shall carry out Aadhaar authenticated distribution by maintaining social distance and following COVID-19 Guidelines/Advisories issued by Government from time to time.

It shall be ensured availability of sanitizers/clean clothes/cotton at Fair Price Shops for cleaning up the fingerprint scanner on e-PoS after every transaction. In case of use of IRIS, the IRIS device can be kept closer to eye lid (without touching it) for scanning of retina. However, Fair Price Shop Dealers shall be directed to prefer use of IRIS device over fingerprint scanner (fitted on e-PoS device) for Aadhaar authenticated distribution.

In case of special cases including old & infirm, differently able, critically ill and leprosy patients, the earlier practice of bypass shall be followed.

Lifting & distribution of allotted PDS commodities should be carried out as per the timeline mentioned below.

#### DATELINE FOR SUPPLYCHAIN OPERATION

1	Lifting and delivery of allotted quantity of food grains to FPSs through Level-II Transport Contractors	Lifting & delivery to start immediately & completed by 25 <sup>th</sup> August 2021
2	Distribution of Rice and Wheat by Fair Price Shops through e-PoS Device	25 <sup>th</sup> August-21 to September-21
3	Sales data upload from e-PoS Device	25 <sup>th</sup> August-21 to September-21

The following instructions may be followed strictly for ensuing meticulous distribution among eligible beneficiaries.

1. Minimum 25 % verification of sale will be conducted by the Inspector of Supplies / ACSO in-charge of the Block/ULB every month.
2. The distribution of rice may be undertaken as per the dateline mentioned in the table above during which all the dealers will keep their shops open and keep sufficient stock for the Consumers.
3. The door step delivery of allotted quantities of rice by the concerned Transport Contractor (Level-II) to the respective FPS dealer shall be ensured sufficiently in advance by the concerned Procurement Inspector / Inspector of Supplies / Marketing Inspector before the dates of distribution.
4. Distribution of rice and wheat shall be made in all the Fair Price Shops on 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> in first fortnight and 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> in second fortnight in each month decided earlier. However, those beneficiaries who are not able to buy their stock within above date may be allowed to buy their entitlements till end of the month after 21<sup>st</sup>.
5. Distribution of rice should be completed as per the dateline mentioned in the table above. Undistributed allotment of food grains will be considered as Opening Balance while finalizing the allotment for next allotment month (s).
6. Good quality of food-grains shall be distributed to each card holder in the prescribed scale, on proper weightment and at the government fixed rate.
7. Any changes on retailer position / ration card tagging shall be intimated to the district administration prior to the month of allocation.
8. Complaints on non-distribution of food-grains, charging higher price, less weight & below quality norm shall be enquired into by the concerned Inspector of Supplies immediately and action shall be suggested to the proper quarters against the erring FPS licensees for punishment as per the provisions of O.P.D.S. (Control) Order' 2016.
9. Marketing Inspectors / Inspectors of Supplies are to inspect numbers of F.P.Ss as per the stipulation communicated earlier and also report feedback on contact with beneficiaries.

10. Certificate of GPLAC or WLAC will be obtained on proper distribution of food grains every month and submitted to the BDO / Sub-Collector / ADM with counter signature of Inspector of Supplies / ACSO as per Annexure-1 of DSS Guideline.

You are requested to ensure distribution of food grains to the genuine Ration Card holders.
