Sub: Tri-monthly FPS Dealer-wise allocation of rice for families under the State Food Security Scheme (SFSS) for the month of Apr-May-June 2022.

Ref: FS & CW Department allotment Order No. 3970 Date - 14.03.2022

Madam / Sir,

With reference to the subject cited above, the allotment order under State Food Security Scheme (SFSS) for the month of Apr-May-June 2022 issued by FS & CW Department, Odisha, Bhubaneswar, is hereby re-allotted for necessary distribution. A stock of Q.1797.30 of rice for the month of April to June 2022 from State Pool is to be distributed among the eligible beneficiaries under the State Food Security Scheme (SFSS) as per enclosed statement.

The scale of distribution of rice under the State Food Security Scheme (SFSS) is 5 Kgs per person per month @ Re.1/- per Kg. The allotted stock of rice should be released only to those Fair Price Shops (FPSs) which have valid FPS license for the Financial Year 2021-22.

Distribution of Rice and Wheat at FPS point should be made only through E-PoS Device wherever PoS device has been delivered to the FPS. Sales through manual mode should be discouraged as far as practicable. However, in case of any exigencies or in worst circumstances, such manual mode of distribution should be resorted to only after due approval of concerned ADM, BDO/EO or CSO with proper justification. In such case, the stock/sales records must be kept for future reference / verification & the physical balance should be entered by Marketing Inspectors in the FPS portal for the concerned Fair Price Shop (FPS) at the end of the distribution.

The FPS-wise Sales Register will also be made available for download in the e-PoS devices to carry out distribution of rice to the eligible beneficiaries. This should be downloaded in PoS device on or after 1<sup>st</sup> date of the allotment month and distribution should be made accordingly through PoS device.


