

Sub: Monthly FPS Dealer-wise allocation of Rice under Annapurna Scheme for the month of February-2023

Ref: FS & CW Department allotment Order No. 2538, Date 09/02/2023

Madam / Sir,

With reference to the subject cited above, the FPS & Block/ULB wise allotment rice under Annapurna Scheme for the month of February-2023 is enclosed herewith for distribution to the beneficiaries. The allotted stock of rice is to be distributed to the Annapurna beneficiaries @ 10 kg per month on free of cost. A stock of Q.17.10 of (Normal rice) is to be distributed among the Annapurna beneficiaries for the month of February-2023 as per the enclosed statement.

The beneficiaries those who are already covered under NOAPS have been kept in Annapurna suspect List-(NOAPS) in RCMS login dashboard. The ISs/MIs I/c of Block/ULBs shall be directed to make field verification and if the beneficiary found eligible, shall be moved to Final Annapurna list. Further, an existing beneficiary under Annapurna scheme, it found not existing either in NFS or SFSS database based on identification through Aadhar, shall be moved to eligible list.

1. The allotted PDS stocks should be released only to those Fair Price shops which have valid FPS license /renewal for the Financial year 2022-23 (till 31<sup>st</sup> March-2023)
2. ISs/MIs in charge of Blocks and ULBs shall deduct the un-distributed quantities (closing balance if any) of foodgrains at Fair Price Shops of previous allotment month(s) from the current months' allocation and issue remaining stocks from the RRC-cum-DSC accordingly.
3. Lifting & distribution of allotted Annapurna rice should be carried out simultaneously alongwith with NFSA and SFSS lifting and distribution.
4. Distribution of stocks at FPS points should be made only through e-PoS devices.. Under no circumstances, manual mode distribution should be allowed.
5. Post allotment /card tagging/rationalization should be given effect to in RCMS immediately, so that it gets reflected in next months' allotment/revised allotment (if any). In case of one-to-one merging of FPS allotments (total quantities of one FPS to be merged with another FPS), mail to be sent from official CSO mail ID to [domains.pmutpds@gmail.com](mailto:domains.pmutpds@gmail.com) for giving effect in RCMS &SCMS for smooth lifting. In case of distribution, the e-PoS device should be retrieved from the outgoing FPS Dealer and distribution should be made after downloading the allotment through the same device, without changing the configuration. Once distribution is completed and data uploaded to FPS server, the device should be re-configured with any newFPS code.
6. In no case, RRC-cum-DSC shall issue stocks of rice & above the Allocation Orders

communicated by the FS&CW Department/OSCSC Ltd/CSO-cum-District Manager.

11. Implementation online Stock Receipt feature in e-PoS: In order to stop erroneous entries made in e-PoS during receipt of PDS stocks from RRC-cum-DSCs, online integration of SCMS despatches (through FPS Acceptance Note) with FPS server has been done. FPSAN generated in RRC-cum-DSCs are now being pulled into FPS server at a frequency of every 30 minutes. The pulled FPSANs are made available in e-PoS devices in near real-time mode. On clicking 'Stock Receive' tab in e-PoS, Dealer will see all available FPS Acceptance Notes despatched from RRC-cum-DSC to choose the specific FPSAN and then select item to receive. This will eliminate the need for dealer to enter the FPSAN number manually thereby avoiding any errors during entry of FPSAN quantity. However, in extreme case, if FPSAN is not available (because of poor network connectivity of device), option to manually enter FPSAN is still available.

The FPS-wise Sales Register has also been made available for download in the e-PoS devices to carry out distribution of food grain entitlement to beneficiaries. This should be downloaded in PoS device on or after 1<sup>st</sup> date of the allotment month and distribution should be made accordingly through PoS device.

**Other instructions:**


- I. Per Card entitlement of food grains will not be reduced below the prescribed allotment. Minimum 25% verification of sale will be conducted by the Inspector of Supplies/ ACSO in charge of the Block/ULB every month.
- II. The distribution of food grains may be undertaken as per the dateline mentioned in the table below during which all the dealers will keep their shops open and keep sufficient stock for the Consumers.
- III. Undistributed allotment of food grains will be considered as Opening Balance while finalising the allotment for next allotment month (s).
- IV. Certificate of GPLAC or WLAC will be obtained on proper distribution of food grains every month and submitted to the BDO/Sub Collector/ ADM under counter signature of Inspector of Supplies/ ACSO as per Annexure-1 of DSS Guidelines.




